Admission is free Monday through Thursday, courtesy of Aetna. Grounds tickets during play on Friday, Saturday and Sunday start as low as \$30. Children 18 and under and adults 70 and above are granted free grounds admission the whole weekend courtesy of the City of Boca Raton.

Premium ticket packages can be purchased for VIP and Skybox seating. For \$275 a day, patrons can upgrade to Club Cambria, located on the 18th green, where they can enjoy unlimited upscale food and beverages with a full open bar. This upgrade also includes VIP parking and access to private bathrooms.
